A massive THANK YOU to everyone who came to last night's PTA meeting. There were 19 of us in total which was fantastic!

We kept the meeting brief but made some exciting decisions with regards to funding requests and are happy to announce that the PTA has voted to fund a new all weather track (subject to planning) and all weather surfaces around the edge of the playground and under the tyres and trim trail! This, I'm sure you'll agree, will transform the outside space, particularly during the winter months.

We also have agreed to fund lockers for the remaining two KS2 classes, forest school equipment, new floats and noodles for the swimming pool as well as an exciting DT project. More details will follow for all of these exciting developments.

The fantastic numbers last night meant we can think about spreading the work of the PTA into much more manageable tasks. We can go back to year group or smaller teams of people taking responsibility for planning

and putting on many of the smaller events throughout the year. This way the work is more manageable for a chair or joint chairs to do and people can commit more time to individual events rather than feel they have to commit all year round.

We do however still need a chair and secretary for the PTA to continue! Nobody has come forward yet! The chair role can be split between two people, reducing the pressure for one person to attend every meeting.

Everyone is there to put on fun events which the children and their families love, at the same time, raising funds which enhance our children's education.
