We wish to create a culture of learning, where children are happy, enthusiastic, motivated and ambitious. We encourage mutual respect, support and collaboration between all adults and children, both within the school and the wider community. We believe that it is important to provide a secure, caring and stimulating environment for all our children, thereby promoting a sense of pride in our school. This can be achieved when all staff, parents and children understand their responsibilities and work together towards the same goals, as detailed in our Home-School Agreement.

## The School will:

- Provide a challenging and stimulating Programme of Study designed to enable all children to reach the highest standards of personal achievement
- Recognise and be constantly aware of the needs of each individual child according to ability and aptitude
- Ensure that learning is progressive, continuous and challenging
- Be good role models; punctual, well prepared and organised
- Maintain an up-to-date knowledge of current Teaching and Learning practice
- Have a positive attitude to change and the development of our own expertise
- Establish links with the local community, including industry, to prepare pupils for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of adult life
- Work collaboratively with a shared philosophy and practice
- Foster in every child a lifelong love of learning.

## The Parents/Carers will:

- Model and promote a positive and supportive attitude towards school
- Ensure that children attend school in good health, regularly and punctually
- Support the school's decisions regarding discipline
- Be realistic about their child's ability and supporting him or her to develop a positive attitude to learning
- Participate in discussions concerning their child's progress and attainment
- Ensure early contact with school to discuss matters which affect their child's happiness, progress and behaviour
- Give due importance, time and space to homework, facilitating reading, and assisting in learning of tables and spellings

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## The Child will:

- Take growing responsibility for their own learning, developing resilience and confidence to tackle new challenges
- Attend school in good health maintained by adequate diet, exercise and sleep
- Attend school regularly
- Be punctual and ready to begin lessons on time
- Be organised; for example, bring necessary kit, take letters home promptly, return reading books regularly
- Conduct themselves in an orderly manner in line with the expected code of discipline
- Look after their own belongings
- Respect the school environment, ensuring that school is kept tidy and organised.
