A Note from the Headteacher

Children are really embracing our value of positivity, showing a 'can do' attitude towards learning across a range of subjects. In addition to introducing new topics, staff have spent the first few weeks getting to know the children and assessing fluency in reading, spelling and mental maths. To support further learning in these areas, teachers will now begin to set weekly home learning tasks from **Friday 30th September**. The tasks are designed to develop fluency and confidence (through reading or practising numbers facts and spelling patterns) or develop inquiry skills (through work that is linked to current classwork).

As there is some evidence that short focused tasks that help to consolidate learning can be effective in improving children's attainment, particularly where parents or carers are engaged in their child's learning, we ask that you support your child in these weekly activities. Homework for Years 2 to 6 will be provided via Google Classroom. Year 1 will be provided with a Home Learning Book which is returned to school each week.

Please find attached our Home Learning Guidance which has been reviewed to reflect current research and means of communication.

Growth Mindset

During our recent 'Meet the Teacher' sessions, teachers discussed the importance of positive learning behaviour and children developing a growth mindset. This is the belief that intelligence is not a fixed characteristic and can be increased through effort. Research suggests that holding this belief enables pupils to work harder and achieve better results. Please support your child's learning at home by encouraging them to persevere (one of our core values) when things seem tricky and to understand that mistakes are celebrated, as they help us to learn. We don't say, 'We can't do it', we say, 'We can't do it YET'.

Now that we are settled back in school, we would love to invite our volunteers to return too!
