Dear parents and carers,

**Year 5 and 6 Visit to The Weald and Downland Museum
Monday 20th November 2023**

As part of this term's history topic, we have arranged an exciting trip for Years 5 and 6 to visit The Weald and Downland Museum. They will be learning about what rural life was like, with over 1,000 years of history to explore!

As you will be aware, parents were offered a choice of coach or making their own way to and from the museum. The poll showed that a coach was preferred for this trip.

The visit is booked for Monday 20th November. We will be leaving school **at 9.00am** and will travel by coach to the museum. Please bring your child to school at the usual time. We will be returning to school at approximately **3.00pm**. The cost of this trip will be **£6.78 per pupil**. Due to a large contribution from the PTA fund, we have reduced the cost to parents and would like to thank the PTA for its support.

Please make payment via your My Child At School account by **Monday 30th October**. If insufficient contributions are received, please be aware that the trip may not go ahead. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium (Free School Meals), your place will be funded and a packed lunch will be provided (please inform the school office if a packed lunch is not required). Consent is still required on your My Child At School account.

Please send your child in full school uniform, and as the museum is mostly based outdoors, with a weather-appropriate coat and comfortable shoes. Wellies or boots are acceptable if rain is forecast.

Please provide your child with a nut-free packed lunch and water bottle, in a rucksack, as your child will be in charge of carrying their own lunch throughout the day.

Travel sickness – If your child requires travel sickness medication, you must administer this before school. If you would like staff to administer it for the return journey, medical forms must be completed in advance, and medication clearly named.

It would be helpful if some parent helpers could come with us, so if you would like to join us on this trip please let us know by contacting the school office. Places are limited so if we are oversubscribed we will draw names out of a hat and let you know.
