As a part of your child's education at Wisborough Green Primary School, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know that, during the summer term, your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus on part of the relationships and sex education (RSE) aspect of this programme. Lessons in year 4 will include pupils learning about: Growing and changing, including physical and emotional changes in puberty; external genitalia; personal hygiene routines and support with puberty. Pupils will also have opportunities to ask questions.

PSHE education is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body. All PSHE teaching will take place in a safe learning environment and is underpinned by our school ethos and values.
