Curriculum

Next half-term, Key Stage 1 will continue to study under the theme of Dragons and Castles, with Years 3 and 4 continuing their learning about the Roman Empire. Years 5 and 6 have completed their study of Ancient Greece and will now begin a new topic: World War II. Year 5 will focus on life in Britain during this period and the impact on family life. Forest School


A reminder that next half term the following classes will take part in weekly Forest School sessions next half-term:
