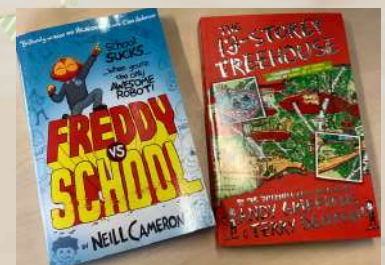


Reception Numicon Workshop
