Rugby at The Weald

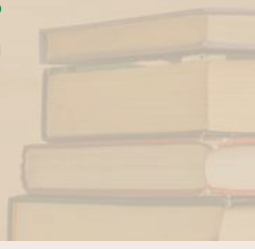
