Our key texts for this term are 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram, 'Toys in Space' by Mini Grey and 'Beegu' by Alexis Deacon



Year 1 will be learning:

- How to write labels
- How to write captions
- How to write simple sentences based on characters
- How to learn and perform a poem
- How to use adjectives to describe facts
- How to form a short narrative

Year 1 will begin to learn the spelling patterns for their year group as well as practising their handwriting

Maths

Previous Reception Experiences and Counting within 100:

- Orally count within 100, forwards and backwards, starting with any number

Comparisons of quantities and part-whole relationships:

- Compare items
- Use equality and inequality symbols (=, <, >)
- Explain what a whole is
- Explain that a whole can be split into parts



Numbers 0-5:

- Partition numbers 1-5 in different ways
- Use bar models and part-whole models to show partitioning
- Show 1 more and 1 less
- Find the missing part when the whole is known

Recognise, compose, decompose and manipulate 2D and 3D shapes:

- Copy, extend and develop repeating and radiating patterns
- Create tangram images
- Identify, explore, discuss and compare 2D and 3D shapes

Science

Everyday Materials:

- Identify what materials things are made from
- Identify the properties of everyday materials
- Sort materials that need recycling and by their properties

Seasonal Change:

- Identify changes in the seasons - Autumn and Winter
- Observe changes in the weather
- Observe changes in the days during each season
