Year 3 and 4 Trips and Workshops

As part of this school year's topics, we have arranged a number of exciting trips and workshops for the Year 3 and Year 4 class:

- **Butser Ancient Farm Trip – Friday 7th November 2025**
- **Mountains and Rivers Workshop – Tuesday 13th and Tuesday 20th January 2026**
- **Monarchs Workshop – Friday 1st May 2026**

We are asking parents to contribute towards all three activities at the start of the school year. The total cost is £11.24 per child. Due to a large contribution from the PTA fund, we have reduced the cost to parents and would like to thank the PTA for its support. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium (Free School Meals), your places will be funded, but contributions would be appreciated.

Please give consent and make payment for all three activities via your My Child At School (MCAS) account by **Monday 3rd November**. Consent is still required if you are in receipt of Pupil Premium.

Butser Ancient Farm Trip

For the Stone Age to Saxon Age topic this term, the pupils will be learning about what life was like throughout the Roman and Anglo-Saxon times, at Butser Ancient Farm. We will be leaving school **at 9.00am** and will travel by coach to the farm. Please bring your child to school at the usual time. We will be returning to school at approximately **3.00pm**.

Please provide your child with a nut-free packed lunch and water bottle, in a rucksack, as your child will be in charge of carrying their own lunch throughout the day. Chartwells packed lunches can be booked on ParentPay by **Friday 24th October**, including those on free school meals (please choose 'trip meal').

Please send your child in full school uniform, and as the farm is mostly based outdoors, with a weather-appropriate coat and comfortable shoes. Wellies or boots are acceptable if rain is forecast.

Travel sickness – If your child requires travel sickness medication, you must administer this before school. If you would like staff to administer it for the return journey, medical forms must be completed in advance, and medication clearly named.

We would like to invite parent helpers to come. If you would like to join us, please let us know by contacting the school office. Places are limited, so if we are oversubscribed, we will draw names out of a hat and let you know.
