Mr Pinder has already established a good relationship with the children, and he will be staying with us for the foreseeable future to provide consistency for the class. He will work closely with the leadership team to support the children through the weeks ahead. Miss Gay and Mrs Alexander will continue to work with the class, with individuals and with small groups. Mrs Barnard our Maths Lead and Miss Jeal our Leader of Learning have already started SATs booster work, and this will continue. Miss Greenway and I will be running an after-school SATs club on a Tuesday (details to follow), and we are keen for as many children as possible to attend.

Mrs Barnard and Miss Gay, who know the children really well, will be taking the children on their residential to Wales in June.

Our priority, as always, is the wellbeing and progress of every child. We will continue to monitor their learning closely and ensure they feel well supported as they move towards their final term of primary school.
