Weald Book Awards 2025/26

A number of our Year Six have submitted entries for this event. They chose from the following tasks to celebrate their favourite book:

Photo: Take a photo or a series of photos of pupils reading the shortlisted books, be as imaginative as you can.

Illustration: Draw an alternative book cover, a scene or storyboard from one of the books, put yourself in place of the character(s) and put in as much detail as you want.

Create: Create a new character to fit into one of the books. It can be a character that is helpful and supportive or it can be one who causes trouble and upsets the story. Please tell us what your new character is like, what they do and how they help or hinder the story.

Letter writing: Write a letter from a character to you or from one character to another in one of the books. It could even be a text or email conversation between you or them. Think about the emotions in that part of the story and how they might affect the dialogue.

The children's work will be shared at the event, and they will also get the chance to meet and question some of the authors. Each pupil may bring a maximum of 2 guests to the event.
